Read dua of forgiveness in the morning and evening: Allahumma anta Rabbi la ilaha illa anta, Anta Khalaqtani wa ana abduka, wa ana 'ala ahdika wa wa'dika mastata'tu, A'udhu bika min Sharri ma sana'tu, abu'u Laka bini'matika 'alaiya, wa Abu Laka bidhanbi faghfirli innahu la yaghfiru adhdhunuba illa anta</p>	<p>Nay, but man has not done what He commanded him. (Surah 'Abasa, V:23)</p> <p>Reflect - Have you fulfilled your covenant to Allah?</p> <p>Action - Worship Allah by doing everything He has commanded and staying away from that which He has ordered you to say away from. After every salah say: 'Allahumma a'inni `ala dhikrika wa shukrika, wa husni `ibadatika</p>	<p>Knows he not that Allah does see what he does. (Surah Al Alaq, V:14)</p> <p>Reflect - Are you constantly aware of your actions?</p> <p>Action - Have Taqwa of Allah in public and private. Remember Allah sees everything.</p>	<p>A reward from your Lord, an ample calculated gift (according to the best of their good deeds). (Surah An Naba V:36)</p> <p>Reflect on verses describing Jannah and all its delights.</p> <p>Action - Always ask for forgiveness after a good deed.</p>

Fall prostrate and draw near to Allah. <i>(Surah Al 'Alaq, V19)</i></p> <p>Reflect - Is there someone or something preventing you from coming closer to Allah?</p> <p>Action - Beg, cry to your Lord in sujud, it will bring you closer to Him.
